Every year, the town of Bala in the Muskoka region hosts a festival saluting the cranberry, or "Muskoka Ruby" as it is referred to by the locals. Friday is designated as 'Seniors Day' at the Festival, and offers a Marketplace for Crafts and Vendors, plus live Entertainment and a Country Bazaar. On this outing we'll start off our day with a visit to the **Muskoka Lakes Farm and Winery** (formerly



Johnston's Cranberry Marsh), just outside of Bala. While on a Wagon Tour here you will see how the cranberry is grown and harvested (11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.) Then it's on to the fun and attractions of the festival itself (12:15 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.). Please note: lunch is on your own today. On our return drive home we will be stopping in Orillia at the popular **Mariposa Market Bakery** (4:45 p.m. – 6:15 p.m.) where we'll enjoy a **Light Supper** (*Soups, Salads, Sandwich or Meat Pie, plus Dessert and Coffee/Tea*) and a little Shopping time before motoring home.
