

# Pioneers and Mennonites

Start off this enjoyable day trip with a visit to **Doon Pioneer Village** in Kitchener (10:45 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.), an excellent recreation of a rural Ontario village in 1914. On a self-guided tour, you'll view buildings and their furnishings, and there will be costumed staff on hand who will answer any questions you might have. Everything is beautifully restored, and you're free to explore as much as you want. You might even recognize parts of the village where the movie 'Anne of Green Gables' was filmed! Following our visit here we'll motor up to Elmira to enjoy an always-good **Buffet Luncheon at the Crossroads Restaurant** here. Following lunch, a local **Mennonite Guide** will board our coach and take us on a **fascinating tour of this Mennonite region** (2:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.) Highlights include a Covered Bridge, plus a visit to a Mennonite Farm where the owners will discuss the Mennonite way of life, and take any questions. Following our tour we're homeward bound.
